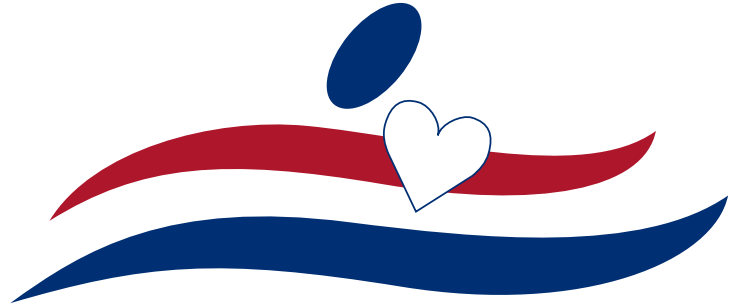


SPORTSCLUB MEMBER SPOTLIGHT



ANTHONY MABRY

Anthony is a 57 year-old father of two grown sons with his wife of 33 years, Mary. After graduating from the University of South Carolina and the University of South Carolina Law School, he went on to be a practicing attorney for 33 years and counting. He became one of our valued members after suffering a harrowing near death experience. He recounts his story, below.

“In 2017-2018 I suffered a series of silent heart attacks resulting in my eventual hospitalization and the implant of a Left Ventricle Assist Device in April of 2018. I had to be resuscitated 3 times. I spent 6-8 weeks in the hospital in Charlotte, N.C. I then began my recovery including working out at the Sports Club in Simpsonville. I had to wear batteries for 2 1/2 years until on my birthday I received a call from Duke Univ. Medical School that they had a heart and kidney available for transplant. The transplant took place on October 17th, 2020 and the kidney was implanted the next day, October 18, 2020. I had to reenter the hospital 2 times with bacterial infections but am recovering. I am still under doctor’s care at Duke and will have to take rejection medicine the rest of my life, but I am alive and well and able to exercise. I thank God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit for saving my life and allowing me to live. I had absolutely nothing to do with it. I also want to thank everyone who prayed for me.”
